Description: People have been thinking about artificial intelligence for a while. ChatGPT has made it a little more real for educators in the last few months. In this interactive workshop we will talk about trends in A.I. related to K-12. We will also get into the potential opportunities for and threats to the way we do business. Beyond the brief overview of the A.I. landscape in K-12, this conversation will focus on the implications for policy and practices, not the technology behind how A.I. works.
