Using a favorite athlete's name with a mix of upper and lower case letters ... 9 seconds to crack the code. Combine letters, numbers, special characters and spaces at least 14 characters or longer. Avoid personal information such as pets' or kids' names, street names, or the model of your car. You can choose a string of random words, an inside joke or an obscure movie quote - add in spaces and swap out some letters and special characters. I am getting many questions in the community about layoffs." Answer: With a majority of any school budget being tied to salary and benefits, it is not uncommon when funding is tight that employees may be laid off. You should refer questions back to the Human Resources Department and/or the Superintendent. Districts administrators will take a look at areas of certification, tenure, hire dates, as well as other information that Board Members do not always have access to regarding decisions that come into play when there is a reduction in staffing.
