SECTION VI AREA SCHOOLS RECOGNIZED AS SCHOOLS OF DISTINCTION OR SCHOOLS OF EXCELLENCE BY NEW YORK STATE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION: To qualify, 75% of the athletic teams must be awarded the scholar-athlete team award. ECASB Schools of Distinction included Alden HS and Lancaster HS. ECASB member schools that qualify for Schools of Excellence include Depew HS, East Aurora HS, Eden HS, Hamburg HS, Holland HS, Iroquois HS, Kenmore East HS, Maryvale HS, North Collins HS, Orchard Park HS, Springville GI HS, West Seneca East HS, West Seneca West HS, Williamsville East HS, Williamsville North HS, and Williamsville South HS.

<u>BUSINESS FIRST BRICK BY BRICK AWARDS</u>: Business First announced recently the winners in the Brick by Brick contest. Recognized in the area of elementary-middle-high school were: Eden CSD for their Middle/High School; the Buffalo Academy of Science Charter School, and the Lancaster Central School District Court Street Elementary Auditorium.

KEEP THE PRESSURE ON: A proposed \$200 million state fund meant to help public schools cover the costs of resolving CVA lawsuits remains stalled in the State Legislator. The good news is that many local school districts initiated the proposed legislation through advocacy on their own and through ECASB. There is backing in the New York State Senate and the New York State Assembly. Part of the biggest arguments that school districts contend is that the statute of limitations was changed by the state. By this change, districts in many cases do not have a record of insurance, many insurance companies no longer exist, and witnesses may not exist. The policy limits in the 60's and 70's would have been sufficient for cases in the 60's and 70's, however, with lack of documentation and inflation,

this drastically affects school finance for the student today. When the ECASB Legislative team starts meeting in September of 2023 - the committee will make decisions on which issues will be a priority that districts and ECASB will advocate for in this coming legislative season.
