John W. Danforth Historical Highlights:

1884 – John Willison Danforth establishes the John W. Danforth Company (Danforth)

 $1967-Danforth\ begins\ providing\ state-of-the-art\ Clean room\ construction\ services.$

2018 – Danforth is named Mechanical Contractor of the Year by Plumbing and Mechanical Magazine, a national publication.

2018 – Danforth is ranked #1 in sheet metal and #5 in piping by Contractor Magazine's Book of Giants.

2018 – Robert Beck takes on the additional title of CEO and is now the President and CEO of Danforth.

2018 – Kevin "Duke" Reilly is named Chairman of parent company JWD Group, Inc.

2020 – Patrick W. McParlane is named President and COO of Danforth, making him the 9th President in the company's history.

2021 – Danforth is named "Contractor of the Year" by Contractor Magazine, a national publication.

2021 – With growth in Central New York, Danforth moves to a new office location in Syracuse.

2021 - Danforth expands into the Columbus, Ohio market and opens an office location in Dublin.
