ALBANY UPDATE WITH DAVE LITTLE - November 2th at Creekside Banquet Center, 2669 Union Road, Cheektowaga. Registration and Cash Bar at 5:30. Program and Dinner 6:00 p.m.—8:00 p.m. Registration closes on October 26th. Register with your District Clerk. David is the Executive Director of Rural Schools Association of New York. Prior to that he served as the Director of Governmental Relations for NYSSBA. He began is career in the State Assembly and then in the Senate where he was Home Rule Counsel and Local Government Counsel to the Majority Leader. David is well connected in Albany and will talk about "Challenges of the Upcoming 2024 Legislative Session".

LATE RESOLUTION SUBMISSION FROM AMHERST CSD - SUPPORT NEEDED! The Amherst CSD is looking to submit a late resolution for the NYSSBA Business meeting. The resolution would ask for an amendment to the General Municipal Law that would add temporary investment options that could generate additional interest earnings for school districts thus helping to offset the local share which would reduce taxpayer obligations. Because the resolution is late, a 2/3 majority vote to suspend the rules during voting needs to occur to allow the resolution to be heard. The resolution is in the email attachment.
