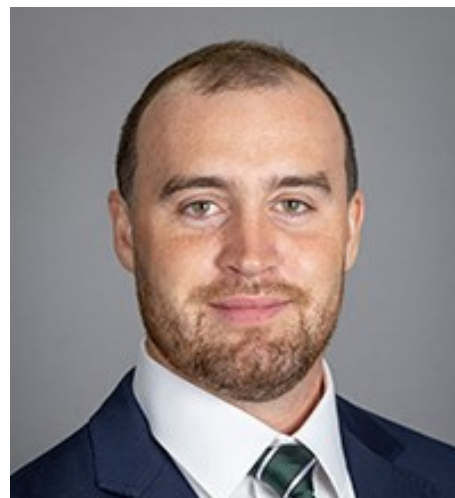




# PROFILE
