BEST PRACTICES: At the West Seneca CSD Board Workshop, the West Seneca Bee came to interview the Student Ex Officio Members. Also sitting in on the interview was the Superintendent Dr. Lisa Krueger. Because the Student Ex Officio Members may not have the experience answering questions from a reporter, it might make sense to have guidelines for Student Ex Officio Members when speaking with the press. Guidelines could include everything from having a the Superintendent present, the Board President present, or preparing students for interviews and only allowing interviews with a set of pre-established questions.

Additionally, I will need to appoint a member to the NYSSBA Resolutions Committee. If you are interested in serving, please let me know. A brief explanation of the committee is listed below.

The Resolutions Committee shall review the proposed resolutions and bylaw amendments

prior to the deadline established by Article 9 of the bylaws. Prior to taking a position on any resolutions, the committee shall have the authority to work with member boards submitting the resolutions to determine whether changes should be made. The committee shall meet again prior to the Annual meeting to discuss any issues that may have risen since the prior meeting to determine if the committee wishes to alter its previous positions. The committee prepares a final report which is presented to the membership at the Annual Meeting.
