<u>DID YOU KNOW</u>: 54% of elected school board candidates are incumbents. 88% of candidates elected were endorsed by their local teachers' union. Many elected candidates did not base their campaign around 'hot-button issues such as DEI, or COVID restrictions; however many of those candidates who did focus on these issues, lost their elections. THEMES THAT WERE COMMON IN MANY RACES INCLUDED: Community cohesion, fostering inclusivity, access to resources, and expansion of programs including STEM. (NYSSBA gathered information).
